## **Library Exchange System**

In Western Australia there are more than 240 public libraries. The main collection of materials belongs to the State Library of WA. To ensure the collection remains interesting an exchange program is maintained.

New and exchange books, audio books and DVD's are delivered each month to ensure that the smaller libraries have a constantly changing collection with different items. So a book may start its life in Lake Grace or Lake King can be exchanged to Halls Creek, Albany, Newdegate and end up in Claremont.

Individual libraries may also have their own donated or purchased collections.

Libraries have their exchange items selected for them and sent by courier from the State Library.



## Unauthorised Fires - Lake Grace

The Shire wishes to remind residents that lighting fires at Shire landfills is illegal and dangerous.

Lake Grace rubbish tip has experienced an increase in the incidence of unauthorised fires and this is concerning to the Shire and Councillors.

Lighting fires at the tip can cause serious environmental damage and pollution, as well as pose a bush fire threat to surrounding land and properties.

Please be aware that lighting fires in an offence, and penalties do apply.

Anyone suspected of arson on Shire property will be reported to police.

## **Paying your Rates**

Pursuant to section 6.45 of the Local Government Act 1995 and regulation 64(2) of the Local Government (Financial Management) Regulations 1996, Council nominated the following due dates for payment in full or by instalments:

Full payment & 1<sup>st</sup> instalment due date 11 September 2015 2<sup>nd</sup> half instalment due date 16 January 2016 2<sup>nd</sup> quarterly instalment due date 13 November 2015 3<sup>rd</sup> quarterly instalment due date 15 January 2016 4<sup>th</sup> quarterly & final instalment due date 15 March 2016

2 Instalment Option - \$22

Admin Fee : 4 Instalment option - \$33

Instalment Interest— 5.5% per annum

#### **Penalty Interest Charges on Overdue Rates**

Under the *Local Government Act* interest charged on overdue amounts. Council has set the charge at 11% per annum which will be applied to all amounts outstanding after 35 days from the issue date of the Rate notice. Penalty interest accrues daily until all overdue rates and charges are paid in full.

Eligible pensioners are exempt from interest charges.

#### **NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS**

Candidates are required to lodge with the Returning Officer:

- a completed nomination in the prescribed form, signed and witnessed. (This form is available from the Returning Officer, the Western Australian Electoral Commission or the Shire of Lake Grace;
- a single A4 page profile containing not more than 150 words of information about the candidate;
- a nomination deposit of \$80 (cash, bank cheque or postal order); and
- a recent passport-sized photograph (optional).

The Commission has developed an online system called Nomination Builder to assist candidates to complete their nomination form which includes the candidate profile. This is the preferred method of completing the nomination form and profile for elections conducted by the Commission. Candidates complete their nomination details and profile, print the completed form which has a reference number allocated and lodge it with the Returning Officer. The nomination builder can be accessed at elections.wa.gov.au

Where an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation signed by the candidate.

The documents may be hand delivered, posted or faxed to the Returning Officer and must be received by the close of nominations.

# Community Consultation

Keeping of Roosters in

Lake Grace Town Site

The Shire of Lake Grace has received two written requests to keep roosters within the town site of Lake Grace. The keeping of roosters is not permitted within the town site under the Shire of Lake Grace's Health Local Law, unless permission has been granted by Council.

The roosters will be kept at the following premises:

- 3 Absolon Street, Lake Grace
- 6 Bennett Street, Lake Grace

In order to assist Council in making an informed and fair decision on these applications, the Shire is seeking feedback from the community through this public advertisement. In particular the Shire would like to hear from those who may be aggrieved by the keeping of roosters on these particular properties, as roosters can cause a noise nuisance to surrounding residents.
