From the CEO

Shire Administration has been working with the Water Corporation and the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation over the past 12 months or so regarding the provision of emergency water supplies and upgrading of existing assets.

We have been successful in negotiating with the Water Corporation in cleaning up the roaded catchment at the town dams east of Lake Grace Town. The Shire works crew will clean up the catchment at the Water Corporations cost.

There are several other projects earmarked across the shire that are being jointly investigated which will provide increased water capacity going into the future. The Minister for Water will be visiting the Shire on $30^{\rm th}$ June to view several of the projects and will be accompanied by several shire and DWER representatives.

Please Note: There is no kerbside recycling collection service in Lake King or Varley.

The recycling bins are collected by Warren Blackwood Waste and transported to a recycling facility. If items which are not recyclable are found the content can't be recycled and the load will be directed to the landfill.

If an item is covered in food, it is not recyclable. Food is one of the worst contaminators in the recycling process. By using the yellow top recycling bin correctly you are contributing, in a combined community effort, to reduce the amount of rubbish that is directed to landfill facilities each year.
