From the CEO



Christmas is fast approaching and there is still lots of work to do. There are several projects under consideration for the future in the field of tourism and housing which will be for the benefit of the shire.

We are still finishing off various jobs around the place and spending the governments money.

You may have noticed the installation of some new water tanks around the shire. These have been mostly government funded and are part of our drought mitigation planning. Through the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation Rural Water Planning section we are taking part in some water evaporation mitigation trials with the first in the procurement stage now which will see the North Lake Grace dam receiving a floating cover. This is basically a turbo charged pool cover designed to reduce evaporation and is touted to last around 10 years. Another trial to be progressed is to place old CBH grain tarps on dam catchments which will enable most of the rainfall to be collected before it soaks into the ground. These will be placed on the main drains into the dams and anchored suitably in place. Trials on the life expectancy of the tarps are currently being undertaken in the eastern states.

Harvest is well underway and we remind everyone to take care on the roads with a lot of trucks around due to what seems to be another bumper harvest. Please be patient, if stuck behind a truck a couple of extra minutes inconvenience is a lot less time than the alternative if you have an accident.

November's Council meeting was fairly light on with the main items being;

- Christmas and New Year extended trading hours for retailers being adopted should they wish to.
- Lake King centenary is coming up in 2028 and a request was received from the community for council to consider putting some money aside in upcoming budgets to assist with the celebrations.
- Council approved the transfer of funds for the construction of Boulton St in Lake Grace to the purchase of a new water tanker to replace the old one as it is rusting severely from the inside out.
- Council considered the nominations for the Australia Day Citizenship Awards. These were decided on and will remain a closely guarded secret until the big day. There are some very worthy recipients.

Lake Grace Harvest Festival, Newdegate, Varley and Lake King Christmas Trees are coming up and we wish them all a successful and happy event.

Recycling Services

Household Waste Collection is a weekly service and collected each Tuesday for Lake Grace, Newdegate, Lake King & Varley.

Recycling is a fortnightly service and alternates between Lake Grace and Newdegate. See below for the upcoming recycling collection dates.

Please Note: There is no kerbside recycling collection service in Lake King or Varley.

The recycling bins are collected by Warren Blackwood Waste and transported to a recycling facility. If items which are not recyclable are found the content can't be recycled and the load will be directed to the landfill.

If an item is covered in food, it is not recyclable. Food is one of the worst contaminators in the recycling process. By using the yellow top recycling bin correctly you are contributing, in a combined community effort, to reduce the amount of rubbish that is directed to landfill facilities each year.
