From the CEO

I thought I would provide some information regarding standpipe water within the Shire.

The Shire of Lake Grace has 18 standpipes within its Shire; 14 are Water Corporation and are directly managed by the Shire and the remaining 4 are managed by the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) as they are connected with DWER-managed community dams.

Water from the Water Corporation standpipes is charged out by the Shire at \$3.00/kl.

Water from the DWER standpipes is free.

The Water Corporation charge to the Shire is \$2.597/kl. It may appear that the Shire is making a profit on the water, however, there are several additional costs which the Shire is liable for.

- There is a service charge of \$272/year per standpipe charged by the Water Corporation.
- There are ongoing costs of \$42/month for the remote access and \$695/year for cloud server access to each standpipe controller.
- An annual cost of \$200/year per standpipe for compulsory backflow device testing.

In addition to these costs, is the ongoing maintenance to the swipe card controllers. For example, there is a small computer and modem inside the controllers which for various reasons require replacement from time to time at a cost in the vicinity of \$3,500 per standpipe. Sometimes, the link to the on-board computer goes down and the only way to check it is to visit the site which in some cases involves a round trip of up to 4 hours in administrative costs. Adding to this, are costs involved with vandalism. Unfortunately, there have been cases where locks have been cut on tanks and water drawn directly from the tank which could compromise the quality of the water and it also means that someone is getting free water.

The benefits of having the standpipe controllers are that the consumption of water can be monitored in the various areas which allow the Water Corporation to plan ahead in times of big water draw downs. Also, these standpipes can be operated remotely allowing us to switch over to "Fire Mode" in case of emergency.

Annual Budget 2020/2021

The Shire of Lake Grace annual budget for 2020/2021 has been completed for adoption during a Special Council Meeting to be held on 29 July 2020 at 10am. This year's budget has been influenced by the COVID19 Pandemic where many major projects budgeted for 2019/2020 were not completed due to the closing of the

regional borders, which made getting materials and supplies extremely challenging as well as the lack of staff to complete the projects.

At the 15 July 2020 Ordinary Council meeting, the following items were discussed and resolved by unanimous vote:

- Permanent closure of Whurr Dam Road, North East Newdegate.
- Review of Policy 5.7—Road Classification.
- Delegations of power and duties provided under the Bush Fires Act 1954 has been given to the CEO, Shire President and Chief Bush Fire Control Officer.
- The Shire of Lake Grace is now a signatory to the Roe Tourism Association MOU along with the Shires of Bruce Rock, Corrigin, Kondinin, Kulin, Narembeen and Quairading.
- Specified Area Rates legal advice was received from the Shire's solicitors and was accepted by Council.
- Due to the COVID 19 restrictions, Council voted to waive user fees for the winter sport users for 2019/2020 and the summer sports users be billed in September/October 2020.
- Council agreed to appoint persons nominated by the Bush Fire Advisory Committee (BFAC) to the positions of Fire Control Officer and Fire Weather Officer.
- The 2019/2020 progress report of the Disability Access and Inclusion Plan was accepted by Council.
- The Porridge Bikers will stay the night at the Lake Grace Pavilion on Friday 11 September to Saturday 12 September 2020, Council waived the hire fees for the Lake Grace Pavilion.

Please Note: There is no kerbside recycling collection service in Lake King or Varley.
