Conditions for Disposal

- Asbestos waste must be double-wrapped in polythene plastic of at least 0.2 mm thickness or otherwise contained in a manner approved by the Director of DWER.
- Must have "CAUTION ASBESTOS" clearly labelled with letters not less than 50mm in height on the wrapping.
- Must be disposed of intact.
- Asbestos can only be disposed of at the Lake Grace Tip.
- Disposal must be during regular tip opening hours, unless alternate arrangements are made (may incur a fee).
- Disposal is to be on or within a range of the Date of Disposal supplied above.
- Carriers are responsible for offloading the material and will not be assisted by landfill staff or machinery.
- The carrier will be invoiced for the disposal of asbestos afterwards, according to the current Fees & Charges.
