Building and Maintenance Team

This fortnight, Wayne Trawinski, the Shire's Building & Maintenance Supervisor reports that works continue on Independent Living units:

- External painting commenced;
- Internal painting complete;
- Plumbing fitout and fixtures complete;
- Electrical work complete and connected to Western Power;
- Air-conditioners installed; and,
- Landscaping complete.

The Building Maintenance Team is still in the process of cleaning out gutters on all Shire owned buildings including Shire managed housing.

The Lake Grace Sports Pavilion upgrade has commenced with disconnection of services, demolition of walls and kitchen.

Road Works

During the past fortnight the Construction Crew have recently completed gravel re-sheeting on Beynon Road and have now moved to Webb Road. The Maintenance Grader has been working on South Burngup Road, Strevett Road, Geliard Road, Beenong Road, Biddy Camm Road and Burns Road. Backslopes were carried out on South Burngup Road and trees have been trimmed on Beenong Road and Brook Road.

The Newdegate grading contractor has been working on Whurr Road, Orr Road and Newman Road and will then move onto Biddy Camm Road, Haig Road, Tonkin Road and Mt Vernon Road.

The Lake King grading contractor has been working on Muncaster Road and Kathleen Road and will then move onto Hogan Road and Biddy Camm Road.

Parks and Gardens

The town maintenance crew have been working in Lake Grace and have carried out works at the Lake Grace cemetery, Lake Grace airstrip, Lake Grace Hall and spraying of laneways and around the main street. The team carried out slashing in Newdegate and various works at the Newdegate Machinery Field Days.

Bushfire Bulletin



Having an emergency kit is an important step to prepare and protect your household for an emergency such as a bushfire.

Keep your Emergency Survival Kit in a storage container in a location that is easy to get to and the whole family knows about.

Things to include in your kit are:

- Portable battery-operated AM/FM radio
- Waterproof torch
- Spare batteries
- First aid kit with manual
- Candles with waterproof matches
- Woollen blankets
- Emergency contact numbers



And don't forget to prepare

for your pets as well. Make sure your pet is wearing an identification tag.

If you're leaving, take a leash, basket, medication, food and a familiar toy for your animal. It will help reduce stress.

Restricted Burning Period

(Permits Required)

19 September - 31 October

Burning permits will be required from Tuesday across the Shire, this includes burning within townsites.

Firebreaks must be in place from the 1 November to the 30 April.

Harvest Bans Zones

All fire zones in the Shire of Lake Grace will be on Channel 11 in an event of a fire.

- When a fire occurs on a property in a zone a *Harvest and Vehicle Movement Ban* will be imposed for the whole zone until the fire is deemed safe, and the *Harvest and Vehicle Movement Ban* is lifted.
- When a fire occurs on a property neighbouring a zone boundary both zones will have a *Harvest and Vehicle Movement Ban* imposed until the fire is deemed safe, and the *Harvest and Vehicle Movement Ban* is lifted.

Sale of Non-chipped Dogs and Cats

Members of the public have queried whether it is lawful for a puppy or kitten to be sold if it is not microchipped.

Under the current provisions of the Dog Act 1976:

- All dogs must be microchipped once they are three months of age; and
- All dogs, irrespective of age, must be microchipped prior to being sold or transferred to a new owner.

These requirements apply to all dogs, unless the owner obtains a vet certificate which exempts the dog from microchipping on medical grounds.

Similar restrictions apply to the sale of non-microchipped cats. While a cat is not required to be microchipped until it is six months old, it cannot be sold or transferred until microchipping has occurred.

These restrictions also apply to impounded animals held by a local government.

To assist, the department has produced fact sheets which summarise the legal obligations of pet ownership for cat and dog owners. The fact sheets are available on the department's cats and dogs page.
