Remember if you post your vote the Returning Officer must receive it **before 6.00pm on election day**. Make sure you post it in plenty of time.

The result of an election is determined by counting the number of votes received by each candidate in the count.

Close of poll is 6:00pm on Saturday 21 October.

Budget 2017/2018

The Shire held a Special Budget Meeting on Friday 29 September in the Council Chambers to adopt the 2017/2018 Budget. The budget was adopted with a general rate increase of 2.5%.

Enterprising Communities - Community Film Nights

The films will highlight successful enterprises initiated and driven by communities to inspire and motivate other communities across the Wheatbelt. The evening is an opportunity to watch documentaries in company with some nice people, catch up socially and enjoy a good discussion afterwards of how good our community is, but also how we can make it better.

We have a great facilitator coming to the three evenings who has already run a similar workshop for Goomalling and she will make notes of any options, ideas and interest that come out of the Film Nights. Part of the project was to set up a Community Enterprise group, but we already have great community groups that are working well, so we have asked them to partnership with these exciting groups, and this was approved. The benefits of the film nights will extend well beyond the Community Movie Night.

These events strongly align with the Social Objective identified by the community in the Shire of Lake Grace's Community Strategic Plan that "a strong community spirit was precious and to be protected", and need to be supported.

Building and Maintenance Team

This fortnight, Wayne Trawinski, the Shire's Building & Maintenance Supervisor reports that the team mainly continued work on the Independent Living units:

- External painting continues;
- · Mirrors have been fitted; and,
- · Phone service connection process commenced.

Other maintenance completed over the past fortnight:

- Lake Grace Netball courts; and,
- Lake Grace Swimming Pool.

Road Works

During the past fortnight, the Construction Crew has been working on Burns Road. They will continue working between Burns and White Dam Road for the next few weeks.

The Lake Grace Maintenance Grader has been working on Harvey Road, Griffin Road, McGlinn Road, Biddy-Camm Road, Trevenen Road, Crook Road, Wyatt Road and continuing on North Burngup Road. Trimming of overhanging trees and roadside tidy-up on various roads has also been undertaken.

The Newdegate grading contractor, over the past fortnight has worked on the north part of Tonkin Road, Orr Road, Newman Road, Biddy Buniche Road, Buniche North Road and Dykes Roads. They are currently grading Lockhart Road.

In the future the Newdegate grading contract will be looking to do Mt Sheridan Road, south part of Vernon Road (north part was done earlier in September), south part of Tonkin Road, Haig Road, Old Ravensthorpe Road and Magenta Road.

The Lake King grading contractor has finished Hogan Road and Norseman Road and currently working on Hatters Hill Road.

The Fire Management Notice provides restricted burning times, firebreak information, information for harvest bans and machinery movement bans and a list of the Shire's current Fire Control Officers.



Bushfire Bulletin



Restricted Burning Period

(Permits Required)

19 September - 31 October

Burning permits are required across the Shire, this includes burning within townsites.

Firebreaks must be in place from the 1 November to the 30 April.

Harvest Bans Zones

All fire zones in the Shire of Lake Grace will be on Channel 11 in an event of a fire.

- When a fire occurs on a property in a zone a
 Harvest and Vehicle Movement Ban will be
 imposed for the whole zone until the fire is
 deemed safe, and the Harvest and Vehicle
 Movement Ban is lifted.
- When a fire occurs on a property neighbouring a zone boundary both zones will have a Harvest and Vehicle Movement Ban imposed until the fire is deemed safe, and the Harvest and Vehicle Movement Ban is lifted.

Take care to avoid any dangers and keep up to date.



It is hereby notified for public information, in accordance with section 87 of the *Planning and Development Act 2005*, that the Minister for Planning approved the Shire of Lake Grace Local Planning Scheme amendment on 30 August 2017 for the following purposes:

- Remove provisions and definitions in the Scheme Text that have been superseded by the *Planning* and *Development* (Local Planning Schemes) Regulations 2015;
- 2. Introduce a new 'Supplemental Provisions' schedule in the Scheme Text and move relevant provisions into this schedule;
- 3. Update all cross references to the Deemed Provisions of the *Planning and Development (Local Planning Schemes) Regulations 2015;*
- 4. Update various terms contained in the Scheme Text to reflect the *Planning and Development Act 2005* and all associated regulations; and,
- 5. Renumber all provisions contained in the amended Scheme Text.
