#### **Budget 2015/16**

I am pleased to advise that the 2015/16 Budget was adopted at a Special Council Meeting held on 29th July 2015. Rate notices will be issued in the week commencing 10th August 2015 inclusive of budget information.

Council is pleased that, despite increased state costs for electricity and water, the budget has been limited to a 3.23% rate increase. Council would also like to acknowledge the Commonwealth's increased road funding under its Roads to Recovery Program which has increased from \$527,000 to \$1.6M for the 2015/16 financial year.

#### 2015 Banners in the Terrace Competition


Students from Onslow Primary School in the Shire of Ashburton have won the 2015 Banners in the Terrace Competition.

## Are You Eligible to Vote?

## LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS Saturday 17 October 2015

#### by Postal Election

If you are registered on the State Electoral Roll you are automatically eligible to vote in the local government elections as per your residential address i.e. you get to vote in the ward in which you reside.

The Shire has 3 Wards: LAKE GRACE WARD, NEWDEGATE WARD & RURAL WARD

Enrolments Close 5:00pm 28th August 2015

## More than One Ward - Owner or Occupier Eligibility to Enrol

You should apply to go onto the Shire's Owner's & Occupiers Roll if you:

- own or occupy rateable property in a district or ward but are not on the residents roll for that district or ward; or
- 2) qualify under clause 12 of Schedule 9.3 to the Local Government Act 1995. and
- 3) want to be able to vote at local government elections for that district.

This year's theme It's Everyone's Backyard is urging

all tidy Aussies to keep their waterways, roads and neighbourhoods as clean as their own backyards during the week of 24 – 30 August 2015.





KidSport enables Western Australian children to participate in community sport and recreation, no matter their financial circumstances. Eligible youth aged 5–18 years can apply for financial assistance to contribute towards club fees. The fees will go directly to the registered KidSport clubs through their participating local government.

Applicants must be aged 5-18 years and have a Health Care or Pension Concession card or be referred by a recognised referral agent. Primary place of residence must be in the local government area that they are applying to.

#### Roosters

It has come to the attention of the Shire's Environmental Health Officer that some residents are keeping roosters in the residential areas of the Shire.



Roosters cause a nuisance to residents with their loud crowing, particularly early in the mornings.

Please note that the Shire of Lake Grace's Health Local Law 2000 Part 5 Div. 2 Clause 5.4.4 states:

If an application is made to the Council for a person to keep a rooster within a townsite in the Shire, a consultation process with residents neighbouring the applicant's premises will be conducted.

#### Roosters, Geese, Turkeys, Peafowl's and Gamebirds

- 5.4.4 (1) An occupier of premises within a townsite, shall no without the written approval of the Council, keep or permit to be kept on those premises, any one or more of the following fowl
  - a) a rooster;
  - b) a goose or gander;
  - c) a turkey;
  - d) a peacock or peahen;
  - e) a gamebird (includes emus and ostriches)
- (2) The Council may upon written application, grant approval with or without conditions to the owner or occupiers of premises to keep any one or more birds as specified in subsection (1) of this section.
- (3) A person who has be granted approval under this section to keep a bird on the premises only while he is the occupier thereof.
- (4) The Council may revoke an approval granted under this section if it is of the opinion that the keeping of the birds specified in the approval is causing a nuisance or injurious, offensive or dangerous to health.
