The success of the community is dependent on full commitment of every committee member.



Newdegate Tanks Upgrade

To ensure we can cater for the growth of the Shire of Lake Grace community. Water Corporation is replacing the existing 90KL water storage tank with two new 60KL tanks. The site is approximately 1km south of the town of Newdegate.

Temporary interruption to water supply.

As part of this work, there will be an interruption to water supply for 5 hours from:

9am - 2pm Wednesday 14 April 2021.

We encourage customers to manage their water supply needs during this time by planning ahead of the interruption. Bottled water will be available from the Newdegate Community Resource Centre from Monday 12 April 2021.

Customers with special water essential work should contact us in advance of supply interruption on 13 13 75.

We appreciate the community's understanding while this essential work is undertaken and apologise for any inconvenience.

Safe Roads WA are carrying out repairs to our bitumen roads and streets in all towns. Tank installations are in the final stages, Newdegate Recreation Centre, Lake King and Newdegate Fire sheds 110,000L tanks are set to be installed mid April.

Our works crew and contractors have been re-sheeting a section of North Burngup Road and Biddy Camm Road from Newdegate North Rd to Kirwan Rd.

Recycling Services

Household Waste Collection is a weekly service and collected each Tuesday for Lake Grace, Newdegate, Lake King & Varley.

Recycling is a fortnightly service and alternates between Lake Grace and Newdegate. See below for the upcoming recycling collection dates.

Please Note: There is no kerbside recycling collection service in Lake King or Varley.

The recycling bins are collected by Warren Blackwood Waste and transported to a recycling facility. If items which are not recyclable are found the content can't be recycled and the load will be directed to the landfill.

If an item is covered in food, it is not recyclable. Food is one of the worst contaminators in the recycling process. By using the yellow top recycling bin correctly you are contributing, in a combined community effort, to reduce the amount of rubbish that is directed to landfill facilities each year.
