At the ordinary meeting held Wednesday 21 February 2024, Council considered and adopted the final draft of the new Shire of Lake Grace Strategic Community Plan for the period 2023-2033 "ASPIRE 2033".

This document is the culmination of over 12 months work by our Elected Members, staff and community members to update and further develop our strategic vision, priorities and aspirations for the district.

Ascentive Consulting from Albany were engaged to assist as external facilitators for the project, which saw a number of community planning workshops held in Varley, Lake King, Newdegate and Lake Grace along with an extensive online survey which received a very positive response rate with extremely useful commentary, ideas and feedback.

The finalised document will now be printed up with hard copies available at our local libraries/CRCs and the Shire Administration Office, and digital .pdf version available to download on the Shire's website.

Making the pledge of commitment at a formal ceremony is the final step in becoming an Australian citizen. Acquiring citizenship is a public declaration of commitment to Australia and an acknowledgement of the common bond of reciprocal rights and obligations enjoyed by Australia citizens.

Citizens pledge to be loyal to Australia and its people; share their democratic beliefs; respect their rights and liberties and uphold and obey the laws of Australia. In return they have the right to vote and to acquire an Australian passport.

Deputy Shire President Cr Stephen Hunt presided over the ceremony which was attended by invited guests of the Turner family and Councillors of the Shire of Lake Grace, and a delicious afternoon tea was enjoyed afterwards by all.
