Most of you will have seen the advertising for the upcoming Festival of Small Halls being held at Newdegate Town Hall on Wednesday 14 August 2024. Posters have gone up in Lake Grace and Newdegate, plenty of information has been shared on Facebook, and in the previous editions of The Lakes Link and Gate Post.

Festival of Small Halls is a joint effort between the Shire of Lake Grace and Newdegate Community Resource Centre to bring live music to our halls within the Shire. It is something that myself and Lucy King (Newdegate CRC Coordinator) are very excited about, and we hope everyone gets behind this community event.

The Festival of Small Halls ethos fits well with what we are trying to achieve, and is why Lucy and I were so keen to bring this tour to the community. If you haven't already, check out the Festival's website (you'll find links on the next page), it showcases some of the amazing rural halls located across the country. On speaking with Shire Councils on the East Coast, Festival of Small Halls is noted as a highlight to their communities, with many inviting the tour back each year.

Festival of Small Halls approached the Shire just as we received a copy of documentary photographer Brad Rimmer's book, 'Nowhere Near.' Over the course of 20 years Brad observed the many small community halls across the Wheatbelt that sat unused, dilapidated or demolished. Halls that had once been the life and soul of rural towns; hosting weddings, wakes, great dances, cinemas, and some that hold plaques with the names of men who went to war and never returned to Australian soil.

He set about photographing these halls, which includes Lake Grace, Varley and Pingaring, and this book now serves as a reminder of these iconic buildings that played host to important moments in Wheatbelt history. Some of the halls documented are at risk of being lost, but we are fortunate that our own Shire halls continue to be well-loved venues within our communities.

It's wonderful to continue to honour these buildings, and what they represent to our communities. It is hoped that this will become an annual event on our calendar, and is rotated throughout the halls in the Shire.

If only the floorboards could talk in our halls... Imagine the stories they could tell! Let's continue to give them a few more for the history books.
