Personalised Shire number plates are a great way to show pride in calling Lake Grace home and to be easily spotted by other members of the Lake Grace community when driving out and about.

There are a few options when it comes to having Shire number plates. District LG plates are the standard state plate, although you have possession of them on your vehicle they remain the property of the government. If a District State Plate comes off a vehicle and is retained, the Shire can only physically hold the plate for 90 days, before it has to be sent off to be destroyed.

If you would like the option of owning the plate outright, you can pay the current fee of \$175 which changes the plate from being a standard plate to an optional plate. This gives you the right of ownership over the plate, which allows you to have the plate retained at the Shire for as long as you need.

Owning an optional plate also permits you the ability to sell the plate on at a later date, or in the event of you passing, pass on to someone via the Executor of the Will, creating a legacy for your number plates.

Sometimes we receive a box of low number District Plates and let me tell you that when word gets out, they definitely don't last!

The other option for owning personalised number plates and showing pride in being from Lake Grace, is by purchasing a set of Lake Grace Shire Plates.

The cost of these plates is currently \$300, with the Department of Transport only charging \$200 and the remaining \$100 is then donated to a group or charity of your choosing. Within the Shire there are plates for Newdegate, Lake King, Varley, Pingaring and Pingrup. These need to be ordered through either Newdegate Field Days or your local Progress Association.

If you are sports minded, you can support your sporting group by checking whether they have any plates available that you can order and purchase.

If you have a plate in mind and want to know if a specific number is available, head to www.plateswa.com or pop into the Shire office and we can find out for you.
