Works have begun on the footpaths along McMahon St in Lake Grace. The brick paving surrounding the town hall is being removed and replace with a new stencilled concrete pattern. This is due to subsidence in a number of areas creating a bit of an obstacle course for pedestrians. The other side of the road will have a new concrete footpath.

The carpark at the Lake Grace Medical

Centre will be receiving an upgrade in the coming weeks. Lake King is to get a new home for the riding club with a lease approved to use an area to the rear of the sports oval. Council saw this as a very worthwhile addition to the precinct.

The Lake Grace Toy Library will be moving into flash new premises soon. The building has now been opened up and some finishing touches to the surrounds are now required.

Highlights from Council

Highlights from the 28 May 2025 Council Meeting:

 Due to the inability of contractors to complete 2 projects by 30 June, footpath replacement along McMahon St has been brought forward and has been commenced. The 2 cancelled projects will now be included in the upcoming budget. Council approved the reallocation of funds.

Highlights from Council continued...

- Council has approved the establishment of facilities for the Lake Equestrian Riding Club
 Inc on a portion of Reserve 20321, which consists of the sports ground and hall at Lake
 King. A lease has been approved with an initial 5 year term with a further 5 year term
 available. The lease is subject to Ministerial Approval which has been received.
- Council approved the establishment of the Lake Camm (Farmer Response) Bush Fire Brigade. The Brigade's profile is to be "farmer response" and the Brigade is to consist of farmer response volunteer firefighters who reside within the Shire of Lake Grace north of Lake King – Norseman Road.
- In anticipation of the approval of the change in designated use of Reserve 46769 by the
 Department of Planning Lands and Heritage to add the use of "Storage Area", Council
 approved the Lease of portion of Reserve 46769 being Lot 364 (79 Stubbs St Lake
 Grace) to Nutrien Ag Solutions for additional storage purposes. This is also subject to
 Ministerial Approval.
- Council approved the waiver of the Lake Grace Pavilion hire fees for the hosting of the Great Southern Junior Football Carnival on the 15th June 2025.
- Council approved the write off of penalty interest rates raised on a property due to the late update to change in valuations prior to settlement.
- Council approved the waiver of hall hire fees for the Lake Grace District high School P&C for the P&C Trivia Night to be held on 19 July 2025.
- Council approved the CEO Annual Performance Review.
