From the Chief Executive Officer

It was great to see a decent rain over the past week or so which hopefully is a sign of good things to come.

Whilst on the subject of rain, it is timely to remind people that when the Shire closes gravel roads or limits the size of vehicles on the roads when there has been a decent rainfall there is a very good reason to do so.

Every time an unauthorised vehicle, or as in the case last week a tractor, goes down the road in very wet conditions it damages the gravel road, sometimes to a degree where it makes it dangerous for future road users.

It costs money to get a grader out to fix up a road, and you might say, "it's the shire that has to pay for it so who cares." Well, we do because it is not our money, it is each and every ratepayer's money that goes into fixing up the roads.

That's money that could go towards resheeting a gravel road, sealing a section of road, painting a building, upgrading a playground or a sport facility. So please give it a second thought when we put out a notice.

The Shire has recently acquired the "Pink Building" located at LOT 352 Stubbs Street. We will shortly be calling for feedback and ideas from residents and ratepayers on the future use of the building. Feel free to think outside the box but please make the suggestions realistic.

The Shire budget for 2025/26 is just about done and dusted for another year. Once again there is a significant amount of funds being spent on roads including some resealing, re-sheeting of gravel, and new seals.

A number of buildings around the shire will be receiving some welcome maintenance and some plant will again be upgraded. Youth and Seniors will also be receiving some significant attention.

All being well the Budget will be adopted by Council at the end of July and the full budget will be released along with the successful recipients of the Shire's Community Funding Program.

Highlights from the 12 February 2025 Council Meeting:

- Council was advised of two Planning applications approved under delegation. These were for some sheds and some new accommodation in town.
- Council endorsed the Audit and Risk Committee's recommendation on the results of the
 effectiveness of the shire's systems and procedures in relation to risk management,
 internal control and legislative compliance.
- The Shire's Activities on Thoroughfares and Trading in Public Places Local Law review was completed with the required amendments.
- Council approved the construction of an emergency grain storage facility in Lake King for CBH. (Interestingly that has now been discontinued by CBH. Too much rain out that way????)




Lake Grace Community Garden Logo - Call for Design Submissions
