It would appear that the new facility at Newdegate won't quite be ready for the onslaught.

The winter grading has now been completed, and attention will now be given to road construction involving re-sheeting and sealing works. Please be vigilant on the roads as Main Roads have recommenced the shoulder widening between Lake Grace and Newdegate.

We are still seeking a Manager of Infrastructure Services to fill the vacant position. We are also on the lookout for an Executive Assistant to replace Alex Adams who is relocating to Albany for personal reasons. This is an ideal job if you are looking for diversity in what you do with no 2 days being the same.

Cr Ross Chappell attended his last council meeting on the 17th September after 16 years on council. Shire President, Len Armstrong thanked Cr Chappell for his service and highlighted his many

achievements during his time on council, including:

- Representation on the Rural Water Council campaigning for the preservation of dams throughout the Central Wheatbelt that were earmarked for destruction by the state government
- Lengthy service as Council representative and volunteer for Bush Fire Brigades and St John Ambulance
- Ten years advocating for improvements to local railway crossings
- Representing council at Progress and Development Associations throughout the Shire
- Light upgrades at the Lake Grace airstrip
- Advocating for doctor and medical services throughout the Shire

Highlights from Council

Highlights from the 17 September 2025 Council Meeting:

- Council approved a Development application for a proposed light industry, commercial vehicle parking and caretaker's dwelling in Lake King, subject to conditions. It is good to see another business in town.
- Council received information on a planned heavy haulage route through Frenchs and Carstairs Road to the boundary with the Shire of Kondinin. At this stage it is only in the planning stage however it is anticipated that there will be 500,000t per annum of gold bearing ore being transported from a gold mine in the Ravensthorpe area to a crushing plant located at the now closed Cosmic Boy mining operation near Forrestania. This will have a major effect on those local roads and planning will shortly begin regarding the upgrade and future maintenance of those roads. We will be looking at a user pays formula that does not put the costs solely upon the shire ratepayers and residents.
- Council approved the use of part of a shire road reserve on Dragon Rocks Road as part of a research project by the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions. This is part of a research project on the threatened Caladenia graniticola (Pingaring spider orchid). This involves the installation of some fencing, water tank and irrigation system and monitoring equipment. The aim is to evaluate whether increasing water availability during autumn and early winter through supplementary irrigation will improve the threat of survival of the species as a result of reduced rainfall.

RESULTS OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTION

Nominations for the 2025 Local Government Elections closed on 4 September. At the close of nominations the number of candidates was equal to the number of available seats, therefore an election will not be conducted.
