At the Ordinary Council Meeting held on Wednesday, 25 March 2026, Council considered a few important items that support good governance, financial responsibility, and service delivery across the Shire.

One of the key outcomes from the meeting was the endorsement of updated Audit and Risk Improvement Committee Terms of Reference, ensuring the Shire remains aligned with recent Local Government reforms and continues to strengthen accountability and oversight.

Council also endorsed the January and February accounts for payment and monthly financial reports, with major projects progressing through planning and delivery stages.
