From the CEO

I am pleased to announce that the Drought Communities Funding Programme Grant of \$1million to help stimulate the economy has been approved by the Federal Government.

Projects include the following:

- Improvements to the Lake King Sports Dam
- A new entry and entry statement for the Lake Grace Sports Precinct
- Roof restoration to the Lake Grace Sports Pavilion
- Installation of solar panels on 12 Shire owned properties throughout the Shire
- Additions and alterations to the Newdegate Country Club
- Upgrade to the septic system at the Lake King Sports Ground Pavilion
- Upgrades to the Lake Grace Sewerage system to allow water reuse on the playing fields
- · New entry statement in Varley
- Lake Grace Bushcare Project to revegetate seven sites of remnant bush around Lake Grace
- Construction of the first stage of the Lake Grace All Abilities Playground
- Installation of a Jumping Pillow in Newdegate
- · Walk trails 5km east of Lake Grace
- Install water tanks at Newdegate and Lake Grace Sports pavilions to capture water runoff for use on the sports fields.

It is our intention to utilise local content where possible to get these jobs done on time and within the budget allocated to each project.

This funding is in addition to the funding we received several weeks ago for another 11 projects throughout the Shire (see our Shire Community News of earlier this month)

These are certainly exciting times and it will be full steam ahead to get these projects completed by 30 June 2021.

These funds will allow us to get some things done much sooner than was originally planned which will free up funds in future budgets for other worthwhile projects throughout the Shire.

Shire Infrastructure News

With harvest starting across the Shire traffic has increased on all roads, this has caused many gravel roads to deteriorate. Our maintenance grading team are working to try and rectify these defects in a timely manner. Please report any issues regarding roads to the Shire office and we will endeavour to get the issue resolved. The Shire is also recommending that all gravel road users limit their speed to 80km per hour and take care whilst on the road as there has been a couple near misses reported already and the reduced speed will hopefully save the roads.

The Shire has received notification that our \$1M Drought Communities Grant has been successful so between now and 30 June 2021 you will see many new projects completed throughout the Shire.

Newman Road standpipe tank is currently out of action but hopefully we can secure a loan tank whilst we wait for a replacement tank to be installed, the nearest alternate standpipes are on the corner of Biddy Camm Rd / Mission road and Newdegate Town.

NEWLY INSTALLED GATES
Access Swipe Card System

START DATE: FRIDAY 30 OCTOBER 2020

This is a courtesy notice to advise our neighbouring shires that the Shire of Kent has now installed gates to control access to the shire tip sites

As part of the Shire of Kent's plan to extend the life of our landfill refuse sites and to meet Department Water and Environmental Regulations (DWER) an automatic gate system with CCTV has been installed. To ensure convenience to the Shire of Kent community, they will be able to access these sites using new access swipe cards.

Access to the tipsites/transfer station is restricted to Shire of Kent ratepayers/residents to make the best of the limited capacity of the tips.

SWIPE CARD Q & A

(more questions? contact the office on 9829 1051.)

Who gets a card ?	One access card per Shire of Kent ratepayer will be provided. If extra access cards are required, a separate registration form must be completed.
Can I take anything to my local landfill site?	No, due to limited capacity the Nyabing Site and Pingrup Transfer station should mainly be used for domestic rubbish. Items such as chemicals, cooking/ waste oil, paint, fuel, LPG gas cylinders, large truck tyres, tractor and large machinery tyres, Asbestos, chemical drums, shuttles, hazardous waste and septage are not accepted at either the Nyabing or Pingrup refuse sites. Tip Access Times: Nyabing and Pingrup (transfer station only)

Days Available: 7 days/week

Opening Hours: 5am to 8pm

This new system will provide swipe card controlled secure access to Sire of Kent refuse sites which along with the development of a long term strategic waste plan, will assist the shire to improve waste recovery and recycling in the Shire and extend the life of the refuse sites. CCTV has been installed at the refuse sites identify anyone who illegally dumps restricted items which may result in prosecution.

Household Waste Collection is a weekly service and collected each Tuesday for Lake Grace, Newdegate, Lake King & Varley.

Recycling is a fortnightly service and alternates between Lake Grace and Newdegate. See below for the upcoming recycling collection dates.

Please Note: There is no kerbside recycling collection service in Lake King or Varley.

The recycling bins are collected by Warren Blackwood Waste and transported to a recycling facility. If items which are not recyclable are found the content can't be recycled and the load will be directed to the landfill.

If an item is covered in food, it is not recyclable. Food is one of the worst contaminators in the recycling process. By using the yellow top recycling bin correctly you are contributing, in a combined community effort, to reduce the amount of rubbish that is directed to landfill facilities each year.
