WALGA Container Deposit Scheme Refund Point Webinar

session webinar on the WALGA Container Deposit Scheme Refund Points.

Western Australia Return Recycle Renew (WARRRL) has been appointed as Coordinator by the State Government to deliver WA's Container Deposit Scheme 'Containers for Change', which is due to commence on 2 June 2020.

An important part of the Container Deposit Scheme is the establishment and operation of Refund Points across the State, to accept the return of eligible beverage containers and facilitate customer refunds of 10c per eligible container.

Lake Grace has been identified as a location for a 'Flexible Refund Point'.

- The role of a Refund Point includes:
- Collecting eligible containers deposited by members of the public and charitable organisations
- Counting and sorting of containers returned
- Facilitating customer refunds of 10c per eligible container returned
- Connecting with the community to ensure awareness and understanding of the Scheme

Anyone can apply to become the Refund Point Operator (RPO) for our location, including local businesses or community groups, providing that they have the capacity to securely store cans and bottles.

Applications to become an RPO close at 12.00pm on Monday 21 October 2019.

Community/sporting groups and schools can also register to become a Donation Point. Donation Points allow the general public, community and organisations to donate their containers as a means of fundraising. To become a donation point, you must have the infrastructure to accept containers from the public, for example a cage in the car park of a sports club. Donation Points do not offer refunds. More information on Donation Points will be available closer to the commencement date of the scheme.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINARY ELECTION CLOSE OF ENROLMENTS Shire of Lake Grace ROLL CLOSE: 5:00 PM Friday, 30 August 2019



You may be eligible to be enrolled to vote in the local government elections on 19 October 2019 if you live in or are an owner or occupier of rateable property in the Shire of Lake Grace.

Residents You are automatically enrolled to vote if you are on the State Electoral Roll as at 5:00 PM Friday, 30 August 2019. If you are not already on the State Electoral Roll and meet the eligibility criteria, or if you have changed address recently, you must complete an enrolment form.

Enrolment Forms

Electoral enrolment forms are available from the Shire of Lake Grace, all post offices, all Australian Electoral Commission offices or the Western Australian Electoral Commission and must be completed and reach a Divisional Returning Officer in Western Australia by 5:00 PM Friday, 30 August 2019.

Non-Resident Owners and Occupiers

If you are a non-resident owner or occupier of rateable property in the Shire of Lake Grace and are on the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll, you are eligible to enrol to vote. If you are not on the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll and own or occupy rateable property in the Shire of Lake Grace you may be eligible to enrol to vote. This applies if you were on the last electoral roll for the Shire of Lake Grace prior to May 1996 and have owned or occupied rateable property in the district continuously since this time.

Please contact your local government for details. Owners of land who were on the last Local Government roll continue to retain that status until they cease to own the rateable property to which the enrolment relates. Occupiers do not have continuous enrolment and should contact the Shire of Lake Grace to confirm their enrolment status. To be eligible to enrol as an occupier, you will need to have a right of continuous occupation under a lease, tenancy agreement or other legal instrument for at least the next three months following the date of the application to enrol.

Joint Owners and Occupiers

If a rateable property is owned or occupied by more than two people, a majority of the owners/occupiers may nominate two persons from amongst themselves who are on either the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll, to enrol as owner/occupier electors.

Corporations

A body corporate that owns or occupies rateable property may nominate two people who are on either the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll to enrol as owner/occupier electors.

Enrolment Forms – Non-Resident Owners and Occupiers Only

Enrolment forms can be obtained from local governments and must be lodged with the Chief Executive Officer by 5:00 PM Friday, 30 August 2019. Further information can be obtained from the Shire of Lake Grace.
