There were 44 nominations across 5 categories for this year's awards with the judges shortlisting 20 finalists.

Lake King

Clean up of tip—there have been hundreds of oil drums dumped at the tip and as a result the truck that empties the waste oil tank has been unable to gain access to the tank. Our team has worked extremely hard to clear all of the dumped drums and a large oil spill, so that the waste oil truck can gain access to empty the tank. The waste oil truck is scheduled to return to empty the tank on Wednesday 31 July 2019.

Please may I ask the community that if the waste oil tank is full that you **DO NOT** block the pathway to the tank with your oil drums. Please inform the Shire that the tank is full, so that we can organise for the tank to be emptied and if you decide to leave your drums at the tip, please ensure that they are left well clear of the access pathway to the tank.

- Lake King Recreation Ground—mowing of the oval, spraying of weeds, maintenance of recreation centre and hall grounds
- Lake King Town Site— repairs to the potholes at the truck rest stop, verge spraying, weed spraying and gardening at the Emergency Shed, mowing, spraying of weeds and reticulation inspection at playground behind the tavern
- Lake King Hall removal of curtains and obtaining quotes to undertake sanding and re-varnish of the floor

Hirer Responsibility When Using Shire Public Buildings

The responsibility of all people, groups, clubs who hire public buildings include:

- Tables and chairs are to be returned to designated storage area.
- All rubbish is to be put into bins provided, including rubbish in toilets.
- Ensure all stoves and lights are turned off
- Any damages incurred while hiring facility will be charged to hirer.
- Facility to be left in the same condition as found upon arrival include the floors.

All external doors are locked, this is most important.

Shire cleaners are responsible for the general cleaning of a facility, however they are not responsible for cleaning up and putting away tables and chairs after a function.

Affiliation fees are set up to help cover some of the costs in maintaining the buildings for the hirer's use which include, but not limited to, general cleaning, water and electricity usage.


